The Mong Community will protest Councilman Dai Thao's Political Bullying, Discriminatory Rhetoric & Lies

The Mong Equality Committee (MEC) will hold a protest at the front of the St. Paul City Hall to condemn Councilman Dai Thao's racist, discriminatory and political bullying conducts towards the Mong community and his unwillingness to meet with MEC as he initially propose to apologize and help heal our community from the division that he created.

After Councilman Thao was called out twice to publicly apologize for his discriminatory misconduct towards the Mong community, his office reached out to Mong Equality Committee (MEC) on March 9, 2022 wanting to meet. Believing that he was genuine, MEC responded and accommodated all of Councilman Thao's requests. Despite MEC's efforts, on March 24, 2022, he shut the door on MEC using various delay tactics and finally backed out on his word by claiming as if MEC had declined his offer to meet.
